- Treasurer Report
  - \$31,409.05 in checking account
  - \$61.80 in PayPal
  - Expenses include Quick Books fee
  - Gail received all of her training room equipment
  - Question as to whether we should have this large of an amount on hand
    - Can we look into some facility needs that could be improved
      - Find a way to un-obstruct scoreboard when games are streamed
      - Purchase something to obstruct view into pool so we can take down sheet – what is status of city approval needed that was discussed last meeting?
      - Check with Michelle
- AD Report
  - Fall Sports very successful
    - Several individuals named all-conference, all-region and all-state in several sports
    - BCC 3<sup>rd</sup> place at state, GCC 11<sup>th</sup> at state, Boys VB top 8 in state
    - Boys soccer and Girls Volleyball won regional championship
    - Football had best record since 2008 season
    - Swim had successful season as well
  - Winter Sports in full swing
    - Boys swim and dive will be competing at East pool
  - Donation from Class of 1960 will be used to purchase girls Track and Field travel bags
  - A few open coaching positions
    - Girls Varsity softball position open
    - John Simon Varsity Boys volleyball coach retiring
    - Will post on WECAN soon as well as other open positions
  - Working with Student Athlete Advisory Council
    - Goal to review different platforms for mental development / training / leadership to use for coaches and athletes
    - Working with officers to pick date for a Bucks game outing and schedule some leadership sessions

- Working with coaches to have a Coaches Night and attend Bucks game for some collaboration and fun
- Anticipate some requests coming from fall or spring coaches – track will likely be requesting bus again
- Red and White fundraiser included on website and during basketball PA announcements
- Membership Report
  - 6 new membership – 3 new families and 3 previous families
  - Five \$30 memberships and One \$75
  - Total of 103 memberships and \$8,135 revenue
  - Could tie in memberships to package deal for Red and White
- Fundraising
  - Bricks
    - Currently in production
    - Could do another push around graduation time to be installed over summer, as this round will likely not be installed until spring
  - Red and White
    - Updated Ask letter will be sent out after the holidays
    - Venue changed to Dugout 54 due to date conflict with J&Bs
    - Date February 26
    - Last year we used SmartAuction site and Andrea’s company covered cost
- Merchandise Report
  - Hawaiian shirt spiritwear option
    - Carrie Hill-Schueller has Spiritwear option of Hawaiian shirts by Shirts and Logos
    - Cost of \$34.75 – we could sell for \$40-45
    - No minimum order needed
    - She can work with Shirts and Logos to set up a website for us
    - We could include some with Red and White or wear them to event; Merg and Arnie could wear some for a bball game
    - Suggest to take name off of collar
  - Spiritwear
    - Over \$800 profit from last Pop-up shop
    - Will plan another in spring
    - Permission was given to sell at January 25 boys home game against Tosa West
- Concessions Report
  - Our best night of sales so far was a night we played Milwaukee JV1 and JV2 teams
  - Boys swimming will have meets here this year we should consider
  - Hoping for better communication regarding added games and cancellations to let families who are volunteering know
  - Prices needed to be raised due to costs – Andy will turn in receipts asap
  - Lines have not been long and we are short of volunteers

- Looking into having Chic Fil-A option
  - Is the 'No food in the gym' a district policy or school policy
- Volunteer Report
  - Hard time recruiting volunteers – what can be done
    - Option to have parent rep to select a few dates and tell families they need to fill them
    - Some coaches forward to their teams and students sign up without an adult
    - Be strict about not fulfilling team requests (ie. Track bus) if families are not contributing
    - We could ask APPSE or other clubs to volunteer, but would need to make sure it is worth their while
    - Can we create better signage to direct fans since it is a bit out of the way
