New Business

- Red and White Update
 - Meeting held last week

 - Advance ticket sales at 211

Old Business

- Treasurer's Report
 - Concessions down, membership up, Red and White up
 - Kate will need a breakdown of what Red and White tickets sales were vs. fees charged
 - Have not given as much to teams this year - \$7,800 vs. \$15,000 last year
 - Net income of \$13,000; balance of \$28,000 – started year with \$15,000
- AD Report
 - Request of a 'super cart' to carry equipment to and from storage
 - Would be used by football and boys and girls track and field
 - Aluminum preferred over wood for weather resistance
 - 5' x 10' size would run \$2,500 plus shipping of possibly \$200
 - Would need after spring break; not sure how long shipping would take
 - Boys track does well with concessions volunteering; football average and Girls track does not volunteer at all
 - We could approve since 3 sports would benefit and then revisit girls volunteering if/when a bus is needed for State
 - Jenny motion to approve, Sara second, all in favor
 - Winter sports wrapping up – playoffs coming up
 - Gearing up for spring sports – schedule set for soccer and lacrosse on new field
 - Pool construction will begin on 12th; more to follow
 - New softball coach hired – Nicki Kaufman
