- Treasurer Report
 - \$32,641.54 in checking account
 - \$119.62 in PayPal
 - Deposits include membership, spiritwear, bricks
 - Waiting for some concessions receipts
- AD Report
 - A few teams hit with Covid – some events cancelled / rescheduled
 - Winter sports about halfway through
 - Setting schedules and scheduling buses for spring sports
 - Bus situation may call for some parents to drive kids
 - Curtains for pool will be installed in near future
 - Please get word out not to shovel turf as it may ruin surface
 - Girls Track and Field bags on the way
 - Request from Boys Cross Country – Mackenzie Laska
 - New warm up jackets needed – current ones are worn and old and do not protect kids from the cold or wind
 - Quote from Holloway BSN of \$65 / jacket – requesting 40 for a total of \$2600 total, plus shipping under \$100
 - Needed by August but would like to order early due to supply / shipping issues
 - Boys Cross Country volunteered for concessions once in Fall and Mr. Laska was scheduled for January 19 game that was rescheduled
 - Will still get credit for signing up even though it was cancelled
 - Mr. Laska will reach out to families and let them know requests are partially dependent on volunteering
 - Not sure if parent rep has received or forwarded emails
 - Bus in spring will be dependent on volunteer contributions as well
 - Decision to wait until February meeting to vote based on volunteer numbers in the next month
- Membership Report
 - 2 New memberships – one \$30 and one \$75
 - Sara sent Kelly list of people who volunteered to help with Red and White or as needed
- Fundraising
 - Red and White

- Still deciding whether to have in-person event or just online
 - We do have in-person school and athletic events, although those require masks and an in-person event with food and drink would be mostly mask-less
 - We could set up protocols beyond what the venue requires, but need to consider venue is in Milwaukee, so that may dictate gathering capacities
 - People don't need to come if they are not comfortable with it
 - May affect advance sales – more at the door sales if people would rather wait and see where things are at
 - Could we do an online survey to gauge people's interest and if they would attend – send out weekly through January?
 - Will have online component for baskets regardless
 - Some coaches do the baskets themselves – make sure to include them in communication
 - Bricks
 - Currently in quality control and will ship within the next week
 - Total cost of \$2,732.98 with \$204.40 of that for shipping – company needs ½ of that as deposit before bricks ship
 - Tracey will work with Leah to get check out and get tax exempt letter
 - Tracey will communicate with Building and Grounds on logistics for delivery
- Concessions
 - Best night was last Tuesday with \$300+
 - Andy paring down on what he is buying, looking for best deals
 - Good response last time sign-up went out
 - Will get Leah receipts and deposits
- Spirit-wear
 - Orders were delivered before holidays
 - Leah received check
- Volunteer Report

- Scholarship Report
