New Business

- JV Boys Basketball – Ken Rudzinski
 - Seeking reimbursement for February 9 service project trip to Feed My Starving Children in Libertyville, IL
 - Team did warehouse / bag filling duties as a team building experience and had team dinner afterwards
 - Request approximately \$525 to reimburse for expense of dinner and renting vans
 - Christine Weisbrock motion to approve, Pat Brown second, unanimous approval
- Girls Lacrosse – Indy Stluka
 - Received \$250 grant through work and donating to Booster Club
 - Request may be forthcoming
- Boys Lacrosse team came through for volunteering; Current coach is different than one who had made request last year
- Signing Day celebration update
 - Michelle drafted communication; will continue our events in December, February, April and additional dates to be coordinated between family and coach
 - Website updated with tips and verbage to help families navigate
 - No Booster Club Chairperson needed at this time

Old Business

- AD Updates
 - Athletic field
 - Building and Grounds met again and project is moving along though not officially approved yet; not part of referendum budget
 - Dr. Ertl and many Board members support, so will hopefully be approved at April School Board meeting
 - 75% chance that whole area will be turf
 - Will start mid-May with projected completion date of August 13
 - Will include lights, but city commission approval not needed
 - Gearing up for Spring season
 - Indoor batting cage used a number of times and working well
- Treasurer Report
 - Concessions revenue and expenses in for year; excellent year with net profits of \$7,885, compared with \$4,102 last year

- Red and White expenses in for year; great year with profit of \$7,847, compared with \$8,006 last year
- Membership down a bit, with \$4,560 this year vs. \$7,329 last year
- Spiritwear had excellent year with net profit of \$3,661 this year compared to \$976 last year
- Currently \$24,644 in account
- Recommend reaching out to teams regarding possible needs
- Membership
 - Currently 101-102 members
 - Do not usually do a Spring push, so probably done for the year
- Red and White event
 - Great turnout – second largest attendance, 216 pre-registered and 20 walk ups
 - Income of \$16,544, expenses up due to pre-order of pint glasses this year
 - \$7,890 going back to teams, \$8,600 to Booster Club
 - 6 year total of \$82,000
 - This will be last year for Pat and Synara to run
 - Booster Club will follow up with suggested prospective parents to take on
- Merchandise
 - Sold \$1,000 at conferences
 - Will sell one more day before end of year
- Advertising
 - Open for next year
- Concessions
 - No update
- Volunteers
 - APPSE stepped up for Regional/Sectional boys games; made \$350
 - Will double check Spring contacts and remind them about volunteer obligations for Fall
- Booster Scholarship
 - Slight mix-up as generic forms were distributed to students by mistake instead of ours
 - When replaced with our form, essay part was not required as the generic one had them write an essay already
 - Will be new contact again next year
